TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the Land Office of the State of Oklahoma, acting in accordance with law, have caused to be surveyed and platted Oliver Park Addition to the City of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma County, State of Oklahoma, and

WHEREAS, the plat of said addition was approved by the Commissioners of the Land Office on the 9th day of August 1911 and was duly recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of said County, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the Land Office of the State of Oklahoma caused the lots in said addition to be appraised, advertised and sold under the provisions of Article 2, Chapter 28, Session Laws of Oklahoma, for the year 1909, and

WHEREAS, the records of the Commissioners of the Land Office show that the full amount of the purchase price, including interest, has been paid, and that S. T. Bisbee, having complied with all the terms and conditions of his Certificate of Purchase, and the laws, rules and regulations in such cases made and provided, is therefore entitled to a patent;

NOW, THEREFORE, The Commissioners of the Land Office of the State of Oklahoma, by virtue of the power and authority vested in them by the constitution and laws of said State, hereby Grant, Sell and Convey unto the said S. T. Bisbee, his heirs and assigns, in fee simple, all the right, title and interest of the State of Oklahoma, aforesaid, in and to the following described real estate, viz:

Lots One to Thirty-six Inclusive, Block Thirty-four,

Lots Twenty to Thirty Inclusive, Block Thirty-five,

in Oliver Park Addition to the City of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma County, State of Oklahoma, according to the plat thereof on file as aforesaid.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Commissioners of the Land Office of the State of Oklahoma have caused these presents to be executed by their Chairman and attested by their Secretary, on this, the 9th day of June A. D., 1924.
