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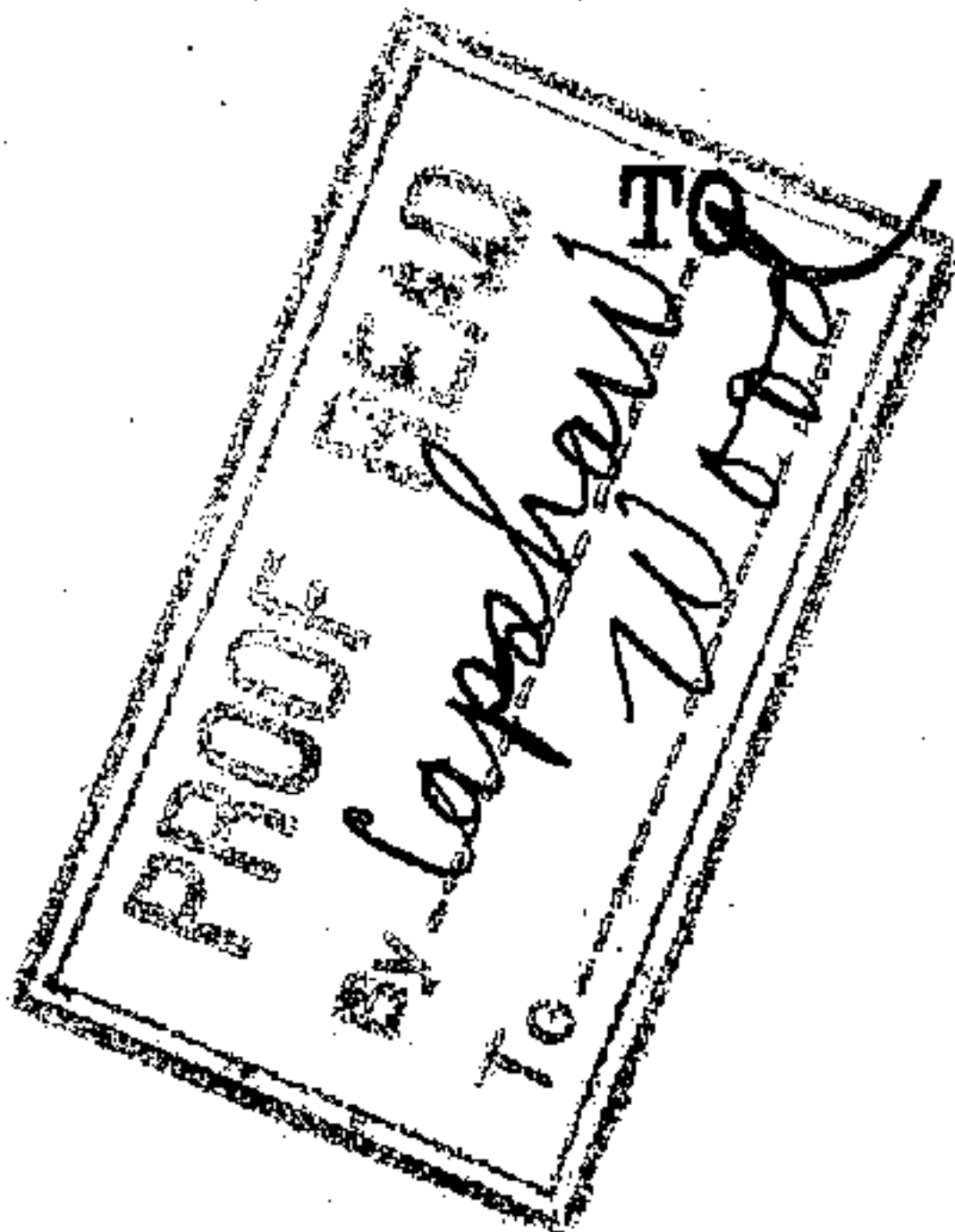

All that part of the Northwest Quarter (NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>) of Section Fifteen (15), Township Eleven (11) North, Range Three (3) West, Oklahoma County, State of Oklahoma, more particularly described as follows;
