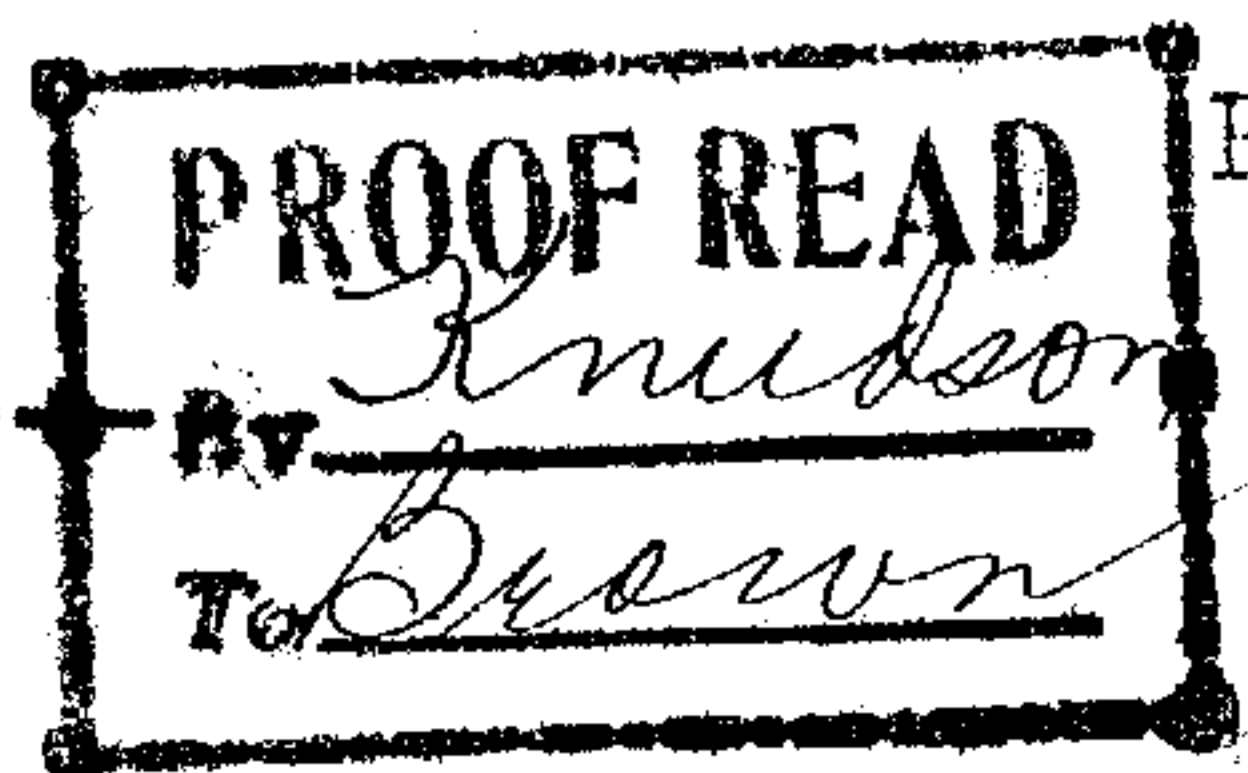

Whereas, under date of the 28th day of September, 1934, Wrightsmith Oil Company executed an assignment of an oil and gas lease to the Mid-Co Tool & Supply Company, which said assignment is of record in the office of the county clerk of Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, in Book 299 page 157 to which original assignment and the record thereof reference is here made for all purposes, as fully as though the same were incorporated herein verbatim; and

Whereas, in said assignment it was provided that the said Wrightsmith Oil Company should be paid out of three-sixteenths (3/16) of the oil and gas produced and saved from the property therein described the sum of \$30,000.00; and

Whereas, such sum of \$30,000.00 has not been paid in full; and

Now, Therefore, know all men by these presents; that the Wrightsmith Oil Company, for and in consideration of one dollar and other good and valuable considerations to them in hand paid by said Larkins & Warr, do agree with the said Larkins and Warr that effective as of the first day of May, 1935, that instead of three-sixteenths (3/16) of the oil and gas produced and saved from said property hereinbefore referred to, to which the said Wrightsmith

would be entitled under the terms of said assignment, the said Wrightsmith Oil Company

Oil Company/agrees to take one-eighth (1/8) of the oil and gas produced from said well and premises above described to apply on said \$30,000.00 consideration, until the same is paid in full, such one-eighth to be delivered to the said Wrightsmith Oil Company or its credit monthly -- as oil and/or gas is produced, and free of expense to the said Wrightsmith Oil Company. And except as herein modified by this specific reduction of said three-sixteenths of the oil and/or gas to one-eighth of the oil and/or gas to be produced, all of the terms of said original assignment of said oil and gas lease shall continue and remain in full force and effect.

This agreement extends to, and is binding upon the heirs, successors and assigns, of the parties hereto.

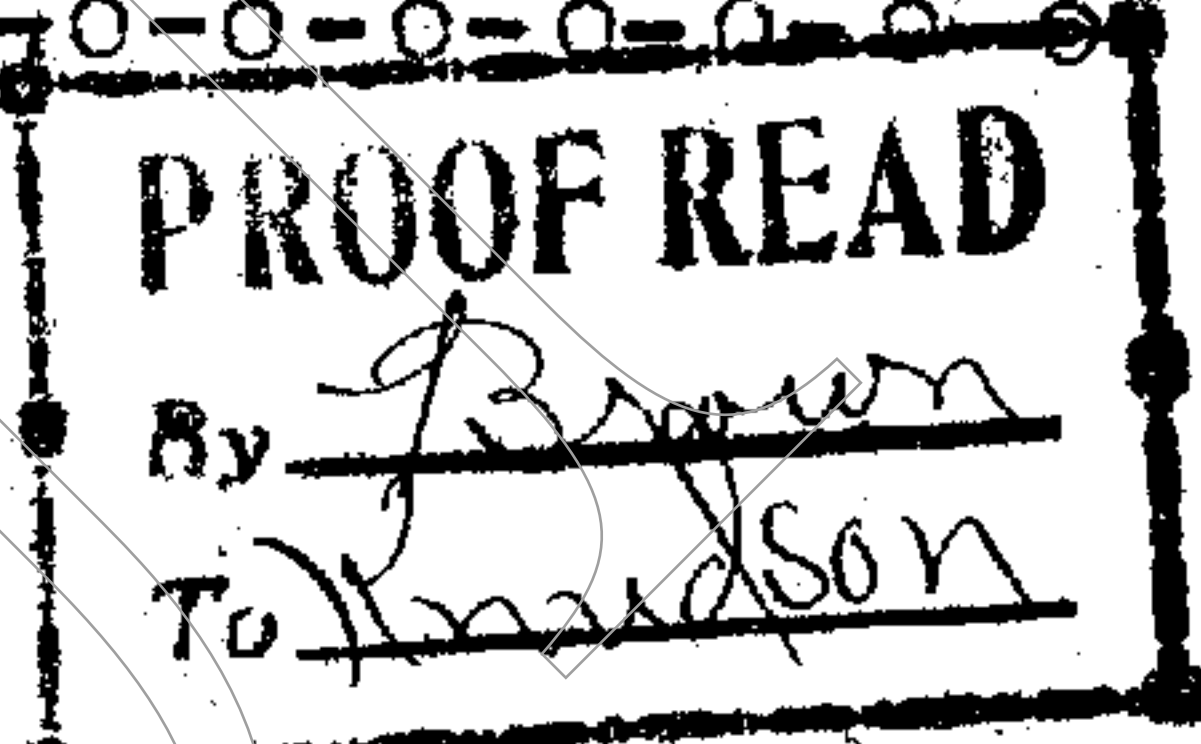
