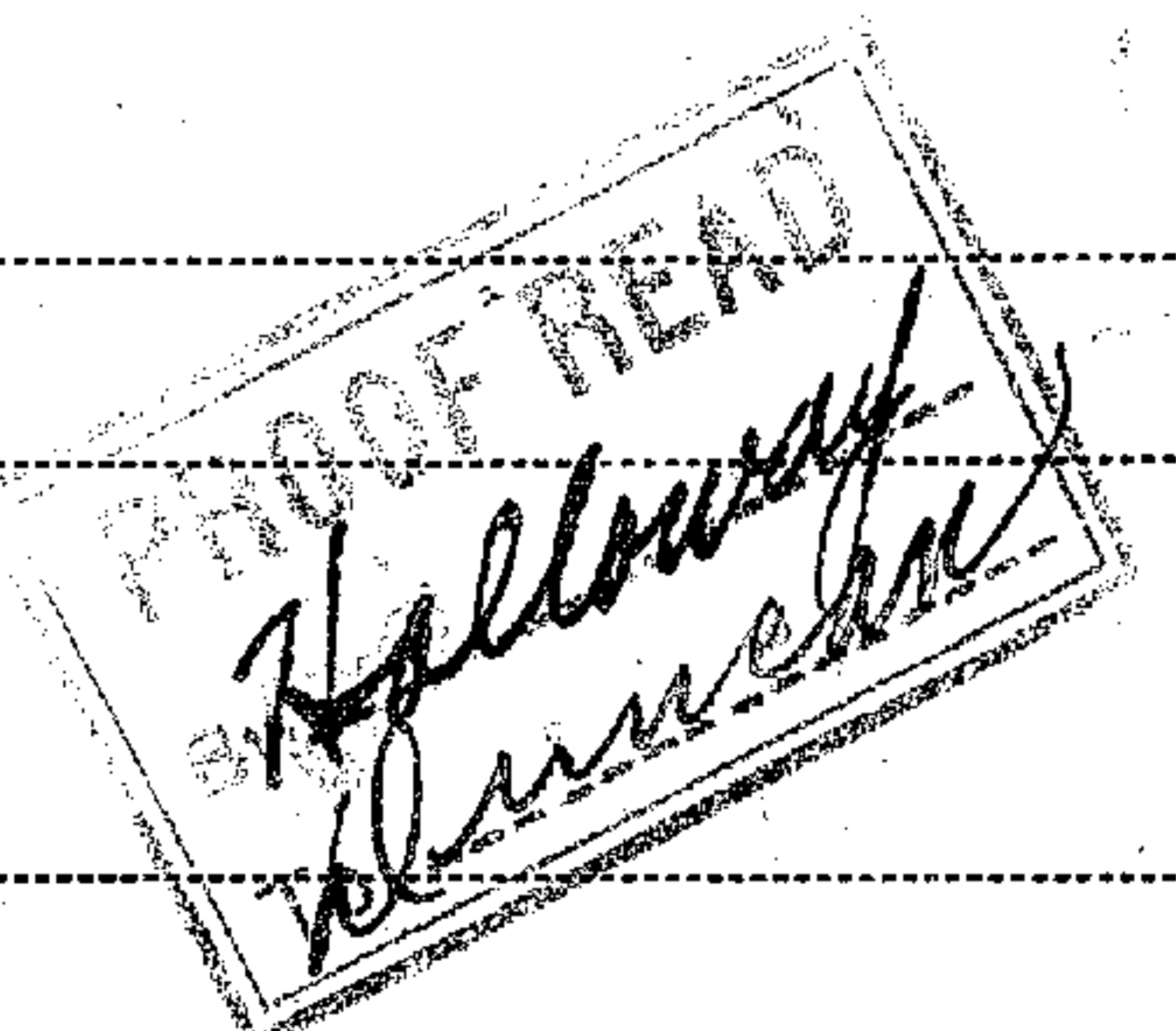

of Oklahoma County, State of Oklahoma, parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of

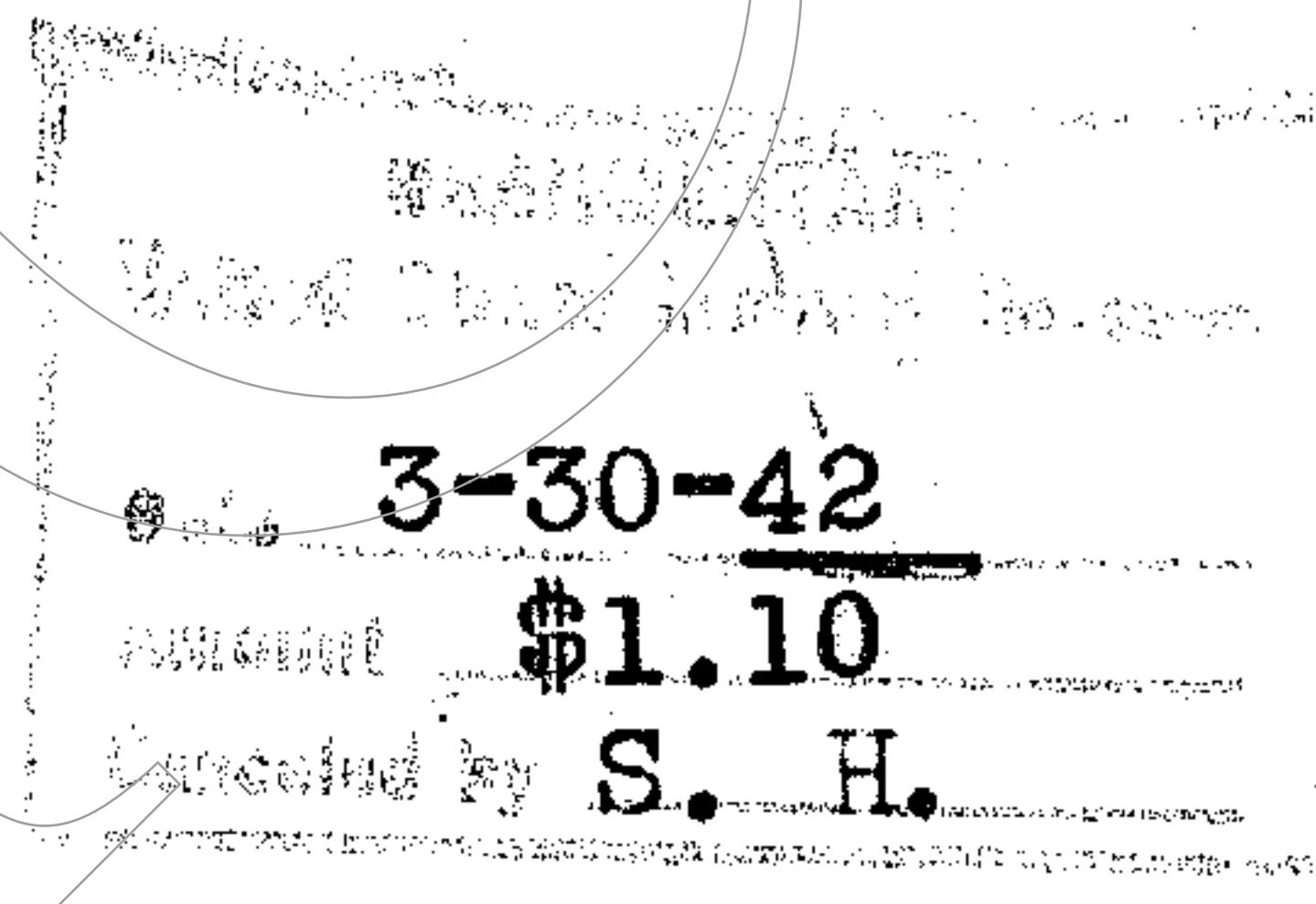
