IN THE MATTER OF OKLAHOMA COUNTY  
SEWER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 5

ORDER DECLARING DISTRICT ORGANIZED

WHEREAS, on May 5, 1958, there was filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Oklahoma County a petition for the organization of a Sewer Improvement District under the provisions of Title 19, Chapter 20, Oklahoma Statutes, 1951 (otherwise designated as Title 19, Chapter 19, Laws of Oklahoma, 1947, as amended by Laws of Oklahoma 1949, p. 180, sec. 1), to be known as Oklahoma County Sewer Improvement District No. 5, which petition set forth the boundaries of the said proposed district and was signed by a majority of the holders of title to lands in the said proposed district, and was accompanied by a map showing the boundaries of said proposed district and the approximate location of sewer lines therein proposed all as provided by law; and

WHEREAS, on said date, the aforesaid petitioners also filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Oklahoma County a Surety Bond in more than double the amount of the probable cost of organizing said district, conditioned as provided by law, and said Bond was approved as good and sufficient by the Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, there was published in a newspaper printed and published in Oklahoma County, a notice stating the time and place when and where the petition would be considered by the said Board of County Commissioners and that all persons interested might appear and be heard, which said notice further contained a brief substance of the contents of the aforesaid petition and described the boundaries of the proposed district, and said notice was published as aforesaid on May 8, 1958, which was not less than ten days prior to the date of said hearing therein stated, i.e. May 19, 1958, at 9:00 o'clock A.M.; and

WHEREAS, on May 19, 1958, in the manner set forth in said notice, the Board of County Commissioners held hearing as provided by law, and said Board determined that the formation of such improvement district, as originally presented in said petition, would be conducive and beneficial to the public health; and

WHEREAS, also on said date, the Board of County Commissioners made an order establishing such sewer improvement district subject to the result of an election to be held therein, ordered the holding of said election in the manner prescribed by law, and ordered notice thereof to be given by the County Clerk also as prescribed by law; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the aforesaid order of the Board of County Commissioners, notice of said election was published, for not less than two weeks prior to the date so fixed for said election, in a newspaper of general circulation in Oklahoma County, and said notice did describe the boundaries as established; designate the name for said proposed district and did require the electors, qualified by law to vote, to cast ballots as by law prescribed; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the aforesaid order of the Board of County Commissioners and to said notice, on June 2, 1958, there was held an election in said proposed improvement district, conducted by the regular election officials under the directions of the Oklahoma County Election Board in accordance with the general election laws of the State at a polling place in the said proposed district designated by the Board of County Commissioners and by the Oklahoma County Election Board; and

WHEREAS, the said regular election officials made their return to the Board of County Commissioners in the manner provided by law; and

WHEREAS, on this 16th day of June, 1958, the Board of County Commissioners did canvass the said returns of the said election and did find that a

majority of all the votes cast were in favor of the organization of said district; and

WHEREAS, the said Board of County Commissioners further did examine all of the proceedings in relation to the organization of said proposed district as above set forth and did find all of said proceedings in fact to have complied in every respect with the provisions of law relating thereto;

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF OKLAHOMA COUNTY HEREBY ORDERS:

1. Oklahoma County Sewer Improvement District No. 5 hereby is organized and established to comprise the following territory in Oklahoma County, Oklahoma,

An area in the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Seven (7), Township Eleven (11) North, Range Two (2) West IM, Oklahoma County, located between Southeast 15th Street on the North, Ina Mae Avenue on the East, Southeast 21st Street on the South, and Bryant Avenue on the West, but the boundaries of said district to be the outer lines of the following contiguous lots and blocks, together with the portions of abutting streets to the center thereof, all as shown by the recorded plats of the hereafter named additions, respectively, Tiled in the office of the County Clerk of said County: (a) Lots 7 to 15, inclusive, Block 1, and Lots 1 and 16, Block 2, and the South 105 feet of Lot 1, the South 273 feet of Lot 5, and all of Lots 6, 7 and 8, Block 3, and Lots 3 and 4, Block 4, and Lots 2 and 3, Block 5, and Lots 1 and 2, Block 6, all in Mansfield Addition, Oklahoma County; and (b) All of Block 3 and Lots 1 to 9, inclusive, of Block 4, and Lots 2 to 7, inclusive, of Block 5, Mansfield Second Addition, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma; and (c) All of Block 2, 3, 4, 6, 7, 8 and 9, all in Mansfield 3rd Addition, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma; and (d) All of Block 1, 18th Street Terrace Addition, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma.

2. This order shall be entered on the minutes of the Board of County Commissioners as provided by law.

3. The County Clerk shall duly certify a copy of this order and immediately shall file the same of record in his office.
