requirements of the law is hereby granted permission to construct sanitary sewers to serve Sanitary Sewer District No. 1102 comprising 1) Lots 7 to 21 incl., Block 4; Lots 2 to 29 incl., Block 13; Lots 1 to 43 incl., Block 20; Lots 8 to 15 incl., Block 28; Lots 1 to 28 incl., Block 37; Lots 1 to 45 incl., Block 45; Lot 13, Block 44; Lots 3 to 18 incl., Block 55; Lots 11 to 14 incl., Block 72; Lots 3 to 24 incl., Block 75; Lots 1 to 44 incl., Block 88; Lots 6 to 16 incl., Block 90; Lots 4 to 34 incl., Block 105; Blocks 1 to 3 incl., Blocks 14 to 19 incl., Blocks 29 to 36 incl., Blocks 46 to 54 incl., Blocks 61, 70, 76, 77, 86, 87, Blocks 91 to 93 incl., Blocks 102 to 104 incl., Block 107 to 109 incl., Assembly Park ~~subject to the following provisions:~~ (located between Hudson Avenue, Harvey Avenue, NW 115th and NW 117th, all in College Park Addition to Oklahoma City, Oklahoma; the east 150 feet of Block 19; Blocks 2 to 8 incl., the south 150 feet and the west 150 feet of the north 141 feet of Block 11; the west 150 feet of Block 10; the west 150 feet of the south 298.3 feet of Block 9; Blocks 12, 13, 14 and 15, all in Homedale Addition to Oklahoma City, Oklahoma; Block 1 and Lot 23 of Block 2, McClures Subdivision, and 2) Block 1, Colter's Sub. of Block 1, Ekdol Heights Addition; Blocks 2 to 5 incl., Ekdol Heights Addition; Broadway Block Sub. of Block 6, Ekdol Heights Addition; Kate Sub. of Block 7, Ekdol Heights Addition; Links Hill Sub. of Block 10, Ekdol Heights Addition; Blocks 11 to 13 incl., Ekdol Heights Addition; Block "A", Ekdol Heights Addition; Blocks 1 to 3 incl., and Lots 1 to 20 incl., and Lots 29 to 48 incl., Block 7, Blocks 8 to 12 incl., Chester Hill Addition, to be constructed in accordance with the plans approved by this Department on March 17, 1961. This permit is issued subject to the following provision:

- 1) That the critical section in the sewer system into which this extension discharges is adequate to carry the present loading plus the additional loading which will be contributed by this extension.
